Waste transfer note issued for every collection.

** For your own peace of mind and legal data responsibilities you should destroy data in line with your own data policies prior to disposing of any data bearing IT equipment.

Free recycling of all old electrical and IT equipment for schools, colleges and universities. This includes your both CRT and flat screen monitors and refrigeration.

Take the opportunity to clear out your old electrical and IT items, no matter how large or small, and have them securely and responsibly recycled at our Approved Authorised Treatment Facility (AATF) in Sittingbourne, Kent. There are no minimum quantities or specifications required and your items don't need to be in working order.

All you need to do is choose from the paid for collection service, whereby the transport costs of the collection are paid for by you or you can deliver* in to us free of charge. Either way the recycling of your items is entirely free.
